## If You Earned a GED



### If You Took the GED (Passed All Subjects):

✉ Recent Test-Takers (all states):

- Check your email from GED.com for a link to download your free electronic diploma & transcript.
- These documents are PDFs, verified and secure (Blue Ribbon Security).
- Be sure to download immediately — links expire.

### If You Got Your GED in Florida

 After Jan 1, 2014:

1. Log in to your account at [GED.com](https://GED.com).
2. Go to My Scores → Order Duplicates.

## If You Graduated from a Traditional High School

### Broward County

 Graduated 2019–Present:

- Contact your school for records.

 2018 or Earlier:

### Miami-Dade County

 Attended After 1990:

- Contact your school directly.

- Send via email, fax, or mail to the Records & Forms Management Office
